State and Federal Advocacy Overview

In 2024, around 14,500 advocates contacted their state and/or federal legislators over 23,500 times total to support or oppose legislation. The most active advocates lived in California and Florida.

CAI has established 36 State Legislative Action Committees (LACs) throughout the United States and a Federal Legislative Action Committee (FLAC) to help advance its public policy priorities. CAI's LACs work to monitor state legislation, educate lawmakers, and protect the interests of those living and working in community associations.

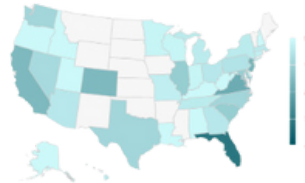

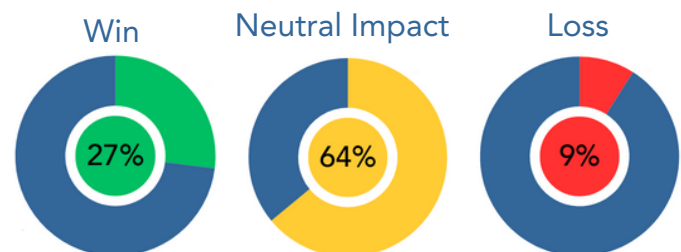
